

How To Donate

1. Make your check out to the school of your choice.
2. On your check's memo (IMPORTANT), write: AZ Tax Credit, GCY, School Name, Program Name. Only checks marked with AZ Tax Credit on the memo line can be honored.
3. Deliver or mail your check TO THE SCHOOL by April 17, 2018.
4. The school will send you a tax credit receipt.

Arizona School Tax Credit

ARS 43-1089 allows dollar-for-dollar tax credit for contributions made to Arizona public schools for supporting extracurricular activities. This includes Grand Canyon Youth programs!

Most Arizona taxpayers are eligible to receive tax credit up to: \$400 (married, filing jointly) or \$200 (filing single).

It won't cost you a dime and it gives you a voice in how your tax dollars are spent. For example: If you donate \$150 to a school's GCY program, you will reduce your AZ state tax bill, or increase your refund, by \$150. 100% of those funds go towards that school's GCY river program.

You don't need to itemize your deductions to benefit from this tax credit. However, if you do itemize, you may also be eligible to take a deduction on your federal income tax return for a charitable contribution.

You must donate by April 17, 2018 to be eligible to take the tax credit for the current year. Use the attached form—it's easy!

All Arizona taxpayers are potentially eligible! Please tell your friends, family, co-workers, and neighbors. You do not need a child in school to qualify.
